No entry fee for Junior riders racing in their category (but must have a license or one-day license).

Course Distances and Descriptions:

Saturday 6th - Time Trial This is an out and back course on a Frontage Road for 20K (12 miles). The course is mostly flat and straight. All racers do the same course.
Sunday 7th - Road Race (see maps below). Depending on your racing group, as shown below, there are 57 mile and 35 mile courses. The **35 mile course** starts in Hillsboro; goes toward Lake Valley for **13 miles**; returns to Hillsboro and finishes with a 9 mile climb up to Kingston. The **57 mile course** starts in Hillsboro; goes toward Lake Valley for **24 miles**; returns to Hillsboro and finishes with a 9 mile climb up to Kingston. Race groups may be combined based on Chief Referee and Promoter consultation.

Registration: Time Trial event \$20; Road Race event \$30; (Omnium \$45). Collegiate discount: TT-\$15; RR-\$20; OMNI - \$30. One day license \$10 per day. One day licenses are for new Cat5 Men/Cat 4 Women and Juniors. All others **must** have an annual USAC license.

Categories; Start Times; Prizes: Omnium ranking follows USAC rule 203(f); points by placing in events. Your event placing is your point score for that event: 1st = 1pt. 2nd = 2pts. 3rd = 3pts, etc. Fewest points wins! Ties determined by fastest TT time. Choose a race group that matches your USAC category. Jrs. 17-18 race with your category. Some categories are eligible for different race groups. Choose the one that fits best.

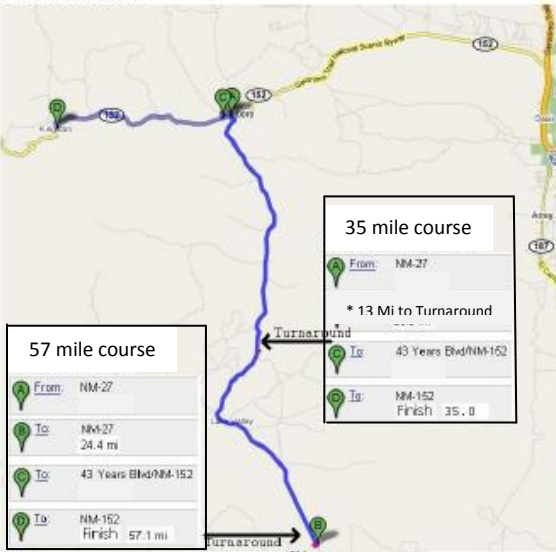
Directions (See map below): **Saturday 6th Las Cruces Staging and Check In @ 10.30am** – From Las Cruces, take I-10 west to exit #132. Enter Frontage Road (in front of the Love's truckstop) and travel west ¼ mile to REA Road. **Sunday 7th – Hillsboro Staging and Check In @ 8.30am** – From Albuquerque, take I-25 south until Hillsboro exit #63 (south of TorC). From Las Cruces, go north on I-25 to exit #63 (north of Hatch). Go west to Hillsboro. Check in is at the community center (Brown stucco building on the hill south of the main highway). There are several houses in this area. Please be careful to allow them plenty of access to their homes. Races Held Wind, Rain, or Shine. No refunds. Held under USA Cycling Permit.

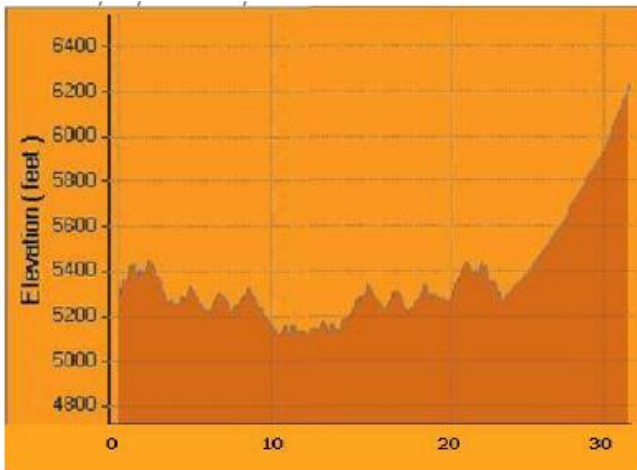
Time Trial Course



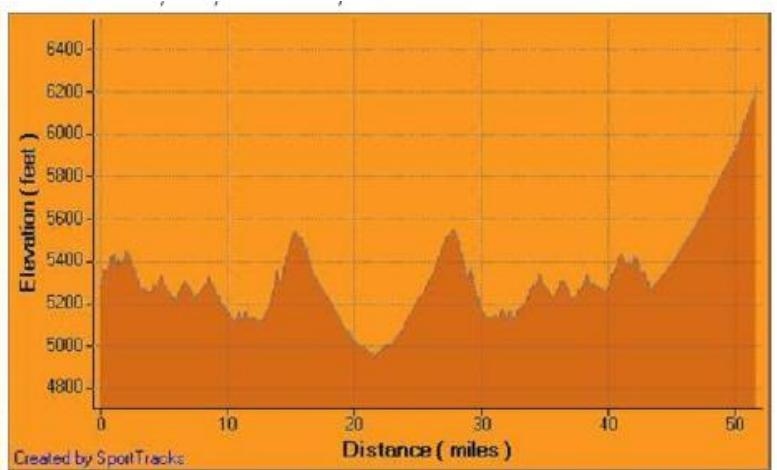
Road Race
