Race (run/hike) starts at the Big Tesuque Campground & Picnic area on Hyde Park Rd. Course is a clockwise loop using the Big Tesuque Trail, Winsor Trail, and Pacheco Canyon Rd. www.santafestriders.org for info and maps. PLEASE CARPOOL. PARKING IS LIMITED! **Race starts at 10 AM.** Check-in opens at 9:00 AM.

Snow shoes should conform to US Snowshoe Association legal size rules. Generally, adult snowshoe models that measure **7" x 20" or more** at the widest and longest (including tail) dimensions are legal. Super small or kid's snow shoes on adults are not fair and racer may be disqualified from awards.

Discount \$15 snow shoe rental at Alpine Sports in Santa Fe – 8 AM in rental shop.

We will have a foot race if snow is scarce, and in that case Yak Trax or other no-slip aids are recommended. Determination of snow shoes or not will be made by the race director on race day.
